**Cable Area Off Road Classic Draws Near Record Field for 2010 Race....**

The Cable Area Off Road Classic mountain bike race drew near record crowds over the weekend. Perfect weather conditions, an early spring and the temptation of a new course brought 400 riders to compete in the 15<sup>th</sup> annual event held in Cable, WI. Brendan Moore from Savage, Minnesota won the 25 mile race in the men's division with an overall time of 1:38:04 while Sara Kylander-Johnson from Duluth won for the women in a time of 1:58:29. Immediately after crossing the finish line, while still trying to catch his breath men's champion Brendan Moore stated "this is the greatest course I have ever race on!" That sentiment was shared by nearly all of the participants. The Cable Area Off Road Classic is a point to point race running from Lakewood's Resort in the Town of Namakagon to downtown Cable along the nationally recognized CAMBA trail system. Top male finishers for the 25 mile race were: Brendan Moore, Sam Oftedahl and Scott Kylander-Johnson. Top female finishers were Sara Kylander-Johnson, Anne Grabowski and Diana McFadden. In the 18 mile race top male finishers were: Timothy Andrew, Kit Grayson and Mark Chapin. For the women it was Diana Munger, Jane Bidwell and Allison Slavick taking the top spots.
